Refund Policy

Students not accepted to the school are entitled to all moneys paid. Students who have not visited the school facility prior to enrollment will be given an opportunity to withdraw without penalty within 3 days following either the regularly scheduled orientation procedures or following a tour of the school facilities and inspection of equipment. Students who cancel this contract by notifying the school within three (3) business days are entitled to a full refund of all tuition and fees paid. Students who withdraw after three (3) business days, but before commencement of classes, are entitled to a full refund of all tuition and fees paid except the maximum cancellation charge of \$150.00. In the case of students withdrawing after commencement of classes, the school will retain a cancellation charge plus a percentage of tuition and fees.

- 1. Once books and educational materials have been issued, they are the property of the student and not subject to refund.
- 2. All refunds will be made within 30 days from the date of termination. The official date of termination or withdrawal of a student shall be determined by letter with date and time.
- 3. Any refund will be given on an individual basis and only in extenuating circumstances such as an accident, health problems that arise after acceptance, death in the family, call up for military service, etc.
- 4. After the first week, if the student leaves for an approved reason, he/she may apply tuition to the next class return by returning at the appropriate time and completing the course.
